WHEREAS, the Board approved staff to distribute RFP's for a not-to-exceed amount of \$25,000 at the January 10, 2012 meeting; and,

WHEREAS, RFP's were distributed to thirteen consulting firms with a response deadline of April 2, 2012. Six valid proposals were received ranging in cost from \$16,500 to \$49,200; and,
