Agenda Title: Adopt Resolution No. 2014-31 to Approve a Memorandum of Understanding between Marina Coast Water District and the Monterey Peninsula Unified School District Regarding the In-School Water Conservation Education Program

Detailed Description: The Board of Directors shall consider adopting resolution No. 2014-31 approving a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Marina Coast Water District (MCWD) and the Monterey Peninsula Unified School District (MPUSD) regarding the In-School Water Conservation Education Program.

The MPUSD and MCWD have worked together for more than twelve years to bring water conservation education to students in the district's service area. This agreement continues the long-standing relationship between the two partners and provides the means to integrate water conservation instruction into the curriculum at five elementary schools for the 2014-2015 School Year.

MCWD shall reimburse MPUSD for the classroom instruction at a rate of \$30.08 per hour plus statutory benefits, not to exceed \$25,800. The instructor will develop and schedule instruction for over 65 classes to more than 1,500 students, teachers and staff. The water conservation instruction provided is designed to meets the state academic curriculum standards and it is age appropriate for children in grades kindergarten through third grade.
