Volunteers Help the District Conserve Water

If you are looking to serve your community and have an interest in our precious water resources, please consider participating as a member of the Water Conservation Commission. The Commission members provide valuable feedback and guidance on important water conservation issues to the District's Board of Directors.

Applications for seats on the Commission are accepted on an on-going basis. Currently, there are two vacancies; one for a seat that serves through August 2017, and one for a seat that serves through August 2018, and applications for these seats will be considered immediately. In addition, four Commission terms start in September 2017, and applications for these seats will be accepted until the July 20, 2017 deadline of 5 PM.

Commission terms last 24-months in length. Commissioners begin their terms in September and serve through August the following year.
