## **Volunteers Help the District Conserve Water**

If you are looking to serve your community and have an interest in our precious water resources, please consider participating as a member of the Water Conservation Commission. The Commission members provide valuable feedback and guidance on important water conservation issues to the District's Board of Directors.

Currently, there are no vacant Commission seats available. But, applications are always accepted on an ongoing basis.

Four new Water Conservation Commission terms start in September 2017, and all applications submitted, up to the application deadline of July 20 2017, will be considered for these seats. The applications will be reviewed at the August 3rd Water Conservation Commission meeting, and later considered at the August 21st Board of Directors meeting. All applicants are encouraged to attend these meetings.

Commission terms last 24-months in length. Commissioners begin their terms in September and serve through August the second year.
