

Water Conservation Commission Update

Below are highlights of the Water Conservation Commission meeting tonight:

1. Pocket Guides to Robert's Rules of Order and Parliamentary Procedure were provided to Commissioners.
2. Commission received a report on the In-school water science and conservation programs and discussed. MPUSD teacher and Coordinator provided comments. I'd like to see these programs expanded next year since conservation is the cheapest way to produce water. I gave highlights of the school education programs at Municipal water district of Orange County where they taught three million students for the last forty years and their education web site is more comprehensive. Staff will look at this program and discuss with the program coordinator. Staff will also look at another District comparable to our District and report to the WCC at the next meeting.
3. Commission reviewed a list of tasks and projects that CSUMB students can choose for their service learning program. Staff will finalize the list from comments made by Commissioners.
4. Commissioners received an update on the implementation of the Stage 3 of the Water Shortage Contingency Plan.
5. Draft agenda items for the February 5 meeting. Commissioner Brown will provide information on the Brown Act.
6. Received oral report on Board actions at the January 5 meeting.
7. Commissioner asked on the status of the letter to be published on the newspapers regarding water conservation.
