


## IT'S FIX A LEAK WEEK March 16 - March 22, 2020

## LEAKS CAN RUN, BUT THEY CAN'T HIDE

The most common types of leaks found in homes are caused by worn toilet flappers and leaking irrigation valves.

Finding and fixing leaks will save you water and money all year long!

## HOW TO CHECK FOR LEAKS:

- Look at the water consumption posted on your January and February bill. If you have a family of four, and your consumption exceeds 16 Units per month, you may have a bad leak.
- To check for toilet leaks, add a leak detector tablet or a drop of food coloring into the toilet tank. If any color ends up in the bowl after 10 minutes, you have a leak. If there is a leak, it is likely due to a worn-out toilet flapper.
- Listen to your irrigation valves for the sound of a leak. If your irrigation valves are leaking, you will likely hear a hissing noise.
