

Please Prepare for Wet Weather

Spring rain showers can often provide much of the water required to keep our gardens healthy. To reduce unnecessary automatic watering during periods of rain, simply turn off your irrigation controller or suspend irrigation prior to anticipated rain events.

For convenience and to prevent water waste, install a rain or soil moisture shut-off switch. District rebates are available.

Soil Moisture Sensors allow monitoring and control of landscape soil moisture levels. Irrigation controllers are programmed to water at an ideal frequency, then the sensor will only operate on those days if the soil is drier than a preset threshold. Plants become less prone to water molds and shallow root growth which tends to eccur with over watering. These derives



which tends to occur with over-watering. These devices save you money every time they prevent an unnecessary irrigation event.



Rain Shut-Off Switches are devices that shut off the irrigation system after there has been a significant amount of rainfall. They are set up in an open area, exposed to rainfall, and wired to the irrigation system controller. Some companies also offer wireless options.
